REPORT OF THE SCHOOL OF THE SAILORS' SNUG HARBOR

FOR THE YEAR 1882

The School of the Sailors' Snug Harbor, established by an act of the Legislature of the State of New York, in 1819, has the honor to submit to the Board of Trustees, the following report of its operations during the year 1882.

The School was opened on the 1st of September, 1882, with a total enrollment of 100 pupils. The number of pupils who completed the course of instruction was 75. The average age of the pupils was 18 years. The pupils were divided into two classes, the first class consisting of 50 pupils and the second class of 50 pupils. The first class completed the course of instruction in 1882, and the second class completed the course of instruction in 1883.

The School was conducted in accordance with the regulations of the Board of Trustees, and the pupils were given a thorough education in the various branches of learning. The pupils were also given practical instruction in the various trades and professions, and were prepared to enter the service of the State or the private sector.

The School was a success in every respect, and the pupils were well educated and well trained. The Board of Trustees is proud to have been able to provide such a thorough education for the pupils, and is confident that the School will continue to be a success in the future.


